Teams are required to pay a \$15 admission fee for each team member which includes a Summer Games T-Shirt. Our friends will have fun things to do besides cheering on their favorite team. There will be a dunk tank, a limbo contest, performances from the Summer Games Cabaret Ensemble, live entertainment, a raffle for terrific prizes, a "Chinese Auction", vendor service agencies, HIV testing and education will be conducted onsite free and confidential.

### **Rules and Regulations:**

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1. Six members per team with two alternates – three males, three females and two alternate's (one male/female). Alternates play only if there is an injury.
2. \$15 per team member entrance fee applies to those purchased prior to 08/29/2015. Entrance fee is \$20 on the day of the event.
3. Team members must be 18 years of age or have signed consent from their parent/guardian. Consent must be signed in the presence of a FACT Board member the day of the event.
4. Impartial judges and time keepers will be recruited by FACT. They will have badges identifying them and be rotated throughout the events. Volunteer judges can sign-up on the FACT website at [www.factlv.org](http://www.factlv.org).
5. All team captains and their members must be checked in between 11:30am and Noon! Check in will be at the vendor area: see Carl Mancino. The names of the two alternates must be submitted prior to the games. If you fail to submit the names, you will not be able to substitute if one of your team members has dropped out of the competition – one of you team members will have to go twice.

### **Scoring of Events:**

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The winning teams of each event will be awarded:

First Place – 10 points

Second Place – 6 points

Third Place – 4 points

Fourth Place – 2 points
